



TRANSFERRING ELECTRICAL SERVICES

As an OSHA Nationally Recognized Testing Lab (NRTL) since 1998, NSF International tests and certifies electrical products for the commercial food equipment, recreational water products, drinking water and waste water.

Certification is important for regulatory acceptance. For example, the National Electrical Code (NEC) states in Article 90.7 that all electrical equipment must be approved. The NEC also states in Article 110.3 that all equipment in the workplace must be listed and labeled by a NRTL prior to sign-off by an authority having jurisdiction (AHJ).

If you are already listed by another NRTL, NSF offers a transfer program that allows your company to transfer your listing to NSF International.

BENEFITS TO TRANSFERRING TO NSF INTERNATIONAL

- > Lower annual fees and audit costs
- > One certifying body for all of your products
- > Higher brand recognition (the NSF mark is recognized by more consumers than many other NRTLs' marks)

THE REQUIREMENTS

- > Current listing with any other NRTL
- > Test report from listing NRTL
- > Last four audits performed by listing NRTL

THE PROCESS

- > NSF's lab staff will review the test reports and audit reports before the listing can be transferred, as required by OSHA.
- > Once approved by NSF's lab team, your product appears in NSF's online electrical listings page.
