If your organization has gone through any of the below changes, please reach out to your account manager to update your organization's records:

- > Changes in employees, such as leadership and/or the quality contact, head count, number of employees, etc.
- > Issuance of a critical non-conformity
- > Facility (opening or closing)
- > New processes (e.g. changes in the scope or removing/adding new processes)
- > Location (e.g. new address)
- > Legal changes (e.g. bankruptcy filing, ownership of the organization, emergencies)
- > New regulations:
 - International Traffic and Arms Regulations (ITAR)
 - Export Administration Regulation (EAR)- U.S. Dept. of Commerce Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC)
 - Defense Security Services (DSS)/NISPOM classified/dark programs. NSF cannot see these programs, but we can assess processes around the secure hardware (not product audit).
 - Other nationalistic programs exist protecting national interests
